

Help for Ukraine

Issue date: July 7, 2022









Recognizing the generosity of Canadians in times of need. Canada Post has issued a semi-postal fundraising stamp to offer our customers and collectors an opportunity to support those impacted by the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Funds raised through the purchase of this stamp will be distributed through the Canada-Ukraine Foundation A donation of \$1 from each booklet of 10 stamps (and 10 cents from each Official First Day Cover) will provide much needed financial assistance to those affected by the situation.

Canada and Ukraine share a historic bond. The first wave of Ukrainian immigrants began to arrive in the 1890s, and Canada was the first Western

country to recognize Ukraine's independence in 1991. Today, nearly 4% of Canadians can trace their roots to Ukraine.

The sunflower, the national flower of Ukraine. has now become a widely recognized symbol of peace and unity and is a fitting image for this special stamp. The bright yellow flower can be seen throughout Ukraine, including as adornment in the vinok, the traditional floral headdress. The colourful stamp, originally issued in 2011, was designed and photographed by Isabelle Toussaint Design graphique. The new booklet and Official First Day Cover were designed by Hélène L'Heureux.

Can you smell the cotton candy? Do you hear the barkers in the midway daring you to test your game skills? This five-stamp issue featuring vintage carousels from across Canada is designed to bring you back to the summer fun of your youth.

From their origins as a military training game in the 12th century, carousels had evolved by the mid-19th century to the mechanically powered fairground ride we still enjoy today. The five carousels featured, with their elaborately carved and painted animals and cheery band organ music, demonstrate both high artisan craftsmanship and impressive technological advances for their era.

The Lakeside Park Carousel, residing at Lakeside Park, in St. Catharines, Ontario, since 1921, still costs only a nickel to ride.

A rare three-row track machine, the **Bowness** Carousel arrived at the Heritage Park Historical Village, in Calgary, Alberta, in 1969.

Arriving in Canada in 1936, the C.W. Parker Carousel No. 119 has been a popular attraction at the Burnaby Village Museum, in Burnaby, British Columbia, since 1993.

The only Canadian carousel to receive the National Carousel Association Historic Carousel Award (in 2010), the Roseneath Carousel has been the pride of the Roseneath Fairgrounds, in Roseneath, Ontario, since 1932.

Le Galopant has been entertaining guests at La Ronde amusement park in Montréal, Quebec, since 2007. Originally powered by steam, the late 19th-century Belgian carousel first arrived in Canada to be part of Expo 67.

The issue was designed by Paprika and illustrated by René Milot in a whimsical style reminiscent of turn-of-the-century carnival and circus posters.





How to order

Payment by cheque

Please make payment in Canadian funds, by money order or cheque payable to Canada Post. Cheques over \$1,500 must be certified. Do not send cash through the mail. The cash-on-delivery (COD) option is not available.

Payment by credit card

Payment by credit card is no longer accepted by mail. Visa, MasterCard and American Express are accepted for orders online or by telephone only.

Returns

Contact Philatelic Customer Service for a return authorization number (RAN) to return an item. The number should be included in the package for prompt service.

Making your selection

Quantity

When expressing the desired quantity, state the number in configurations of stamps required. For example, if you're ordering three upper left corner blocks, write 3 (not 12).

GST or HST

Add 5% GST or 13% HST (Ont.), 15% HST (N.S., N.L. and N.B.) or 14% HST (P.E.I.).

PST

Residents of B.C., Que., Man. and Sask., calculate PST on applicable products.

There is a different product number for each configuration within a stamp issue.

Every effort is made to ensure that product descriptions and suggested retail prices are accurate and up to date, errors and omissions excepted. Canada Post reserves the right to vary prices and product descriptions at any time without notice. Individual post offices may sell items for less.

Free shipping

Free shipping on product orders of \$25 (pre-tax) or more – whether you order online, by telephone, fax or mail, or when you order at the post office and have it shipped to you. For orders under \$25 (pre-tax), a \$4.99 shipping fee will apply (excluding standing orders). Order more and save.
