DATA DICTIONARY – ELEMENT DESCRIPTIONS

Following will be a listing of all record elements for all record types within the Record Descriptions. Each element will include a brief definition and valid codes where applicable.

Elements

UNIQUE ID	Unique Identifier
ACTION CODE	<p>A code indicating whether there has been any change within the record since the production of the last issue. The valid values are:</p> <p>Space = no change A = added record D = deleted record</p>
ALTERNATE MUNICIPALITY	Alternate names, alternate spellings, and abbreviations for many of the municipality names contained within the address lookup file.
CENSUS METROPOLITAN AREA (CMANAME)	Area consisting of one or more neighbouring municipalities situated around a core. A census metropolitan area must have a total population of at least 100,000 of which 50,000 or more live in the core. A census agglomeration must have a core population of at least 10,000
COMMUNITY NAME (COMM NAME)	The rural community name; denotes any city, town or village in Canada
CONFIDENCE SCORE	<p>Confidence Score Identifies accuracy of the coordinates</p> <p>1 = < 50 meters (Urban only) 2 = < 322 meters 3 = < 500 meters 4 = other geocoding methods</p>
DIRECTORY	The major community or greater municipality grouping that contains the street address or its delivery installation.
FSA (FORWARD SORTATION AREA)	The FSA comprises the first three characters of a Postal Code. The FSA qualifies the area within a municipality that is permitted to use the valid alternate municipality name.

POSTAL CODE	<p>Postal Code is a six character, alphanumeric combination (ANA NAN) assigned to one or more postal address. The Postal Code is an integral part of every postal address in Canada and is required for the mechanized processing of mail. Postal codes are also used to identify the various CPC processing facilities, and delivery installations.</p> <p>*Postal Code is an official mark of Canada Post Corporation.</p>
LATITUDE	<p>This is the latitude, in decimal degrees, of the FSA, dissemination area, dissemination block, or block-face representative point. The decimal point is explicit.</p>
LONGITUDE	<p>This is the longitude, in decimal degrees, of the FSA, dissemination area, dissemination block, or block-face representative point. The decimal point is explicit.</p>
MUNICIPALITY	<p>A municipality is any city, town or village in Canada that is recognized as a valid mailing address by Canada Post.</p>
PROVINCE NAME	<p>An alphabetic code listing the province or territory's position geographically. The valid values are:</p> <p>NL = Newfoundland and Labrador NS = Nova Scotia PE = Prince Edward Island NB = New Brunswick QC = Quebec ON = Ontario MB = Manitoba SK = Saskatchewan AB = Alberta BC = British Columbia NT = Northwest Territories YT = Yukon NU = Nunavut</p>
