So, what does it take to be a Letter Carrier with Canada Post?

You will need a valid permanent provincial driver's license and safe driving record. You will also need to be able to perform physical work that might include lifting up to 22.7 kilos (50 lbs), as well as be able to carry mail items up to 15.9 kilos (35 lbs) while walking, climbing and descending stairs to deliver mail in all kinds of weather and traffic conditions for long periods of time. This position also entails walking, reaching, bending, pulling and pushing equipment, climbing stairs and standing in one location for extended periods of time.

To be considered for a position as a Letter Carrier, you must:

- Have a secondary school or provincial equivalent (GED)
- Experience working with the public, driving, and in making deliveries is asset
- Have proficiency in maintaining records, preparing routine reports, organizing material, and handling cash transactions
- Possess exceptional skills in integrity, performance orientation, customer orientation, safety orientation, cooperation, and flexibility.
- Have held a valid permanent provincial Driver's Licence for the past 2 years,
- Have held a satisfactory safe driving record within the last 3 years in accordance with Canada Post requirements
- Provide a current driver's abstract (obtained from the appropriate provincial ministry or agency.), dated within the last 30 days
- Pass pre-employment tests, an interview and a vision and road assessment
- Complete the security screening process and obtain Reliability Status
- Demonstrate that you meet the physical requirements of the job by successfully completing a physical abilities test
- Successfully complete a training program and pass training tests
