

UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITES IN CANADA

Issue date: March 31, 2014

They're wild, rugged, breathtakingly beautiful and a fascinating portal to the past – and not just because Canadians think so. These treasures of Canada have become UNESCO World Heritage sites and are celebrated in this multi-year stamp series, which will include both definitive and commemorative stamps.

Canada's 17 World Heritage sites are deemed so valuable for their natural riches and cultural significance that they are recognized internationally. We introduce the series with five domestic stamps. Travel the rapids and whirlpools of the South Nahanni River in Nahanni National Park, scale the monumental peaks of the Canadian Rocky Mountains, and read the history of the Earth in the magma crust of Gros Morne National Park or in the fossil beds of Joggins Fossil Cliffs and Miguasha National Park.

During the gold rush in what was to become Nahanni National Park World Heritage Site (Northwest Territories), prospectors failed to find their fortune,

but discovered an incredibly varied landscape. Virginia Falls and the twists of Hell's Gate were sculptered by the last ice age.

The pristine ridges and cliffs, bogs and tundra, ocean inlets and lakes of Gros Morne National Park (Newfoundland and Labrador) might be stunning, but this site's World Heritage status was granted due to what's hidden underground - a perfect example of plate tectonics, proof the Earth's continents have joined and separated repeatedly over the eons. Onceliquid magma that filled the gap between plates of Earth's crust remains clearly visible in the cliffs of Gros Morne's Western Brook Pond.

Imagine the palm trees! Nearly 400 million years ago, today's Miguasha National Park (Quebec) on the Gaspé Peninsula was once a tropical estuary. The fossil beds of the Escuminac Formation, exposed in a seaside cliff provide a rare portrait of Devonian life including 21 species of fish fossils that have made Miguasha famous.

Nearly 200 fossil species found in the Joggins Fossil Cliffs reveal the world's most complete record of terrestrial life from the Pennsylvanian Period (the Coal Age), over 300 million years ago. Here we find fossilized reptiles and amniotes, the first vertebrates to reproduce on land, marking one of

the most significant events in the evolution of life on Earth.

Every year, more than nine million people visit the Canadian Rocky Mountain Parks along the Alberta-British Columbia border. These include Banff – Canada's first park preserve – Jasper, Kootenay and Yoho national parks as well as Mount Robson, Mount Assiniboine and Hamber provincial parks (British Columbia). On her choice of photograph to depict this iconic landscape, designer Lara Minja admits that from a climber's bird's-eye view, one realizes the vastness of the surrounding mountain range "and the endless possibilities of discovery."

Minja points out that her overall approach included "contrasts and comparisons in scale, colour, shape, and texture of the environmental elements, both within individual stamps and across the stamp series."

For these reasons, we think this stamp series will invite Canadians to discover more about the wonders of their homeland and explore these sites as they're seen through the eyes of the world.

BABY WILDLIFE

Issue date: March 31, 2014

This year, our Baby Wildlife series wraps up with one last adorable issue. Each stamp captures the early days of some of Canada's more recognizable wildlife: the baby beaver, mountain goat, puffin, wapiti and burrowing owl. With four years of newborn critter stamps to her credit, as well as other Canadian stamps since 1998, designer Sophie Lafortune strives to ensure these youngsters look their best.

"The focus on the animals has kept the series fresh by giving new life to the stamps with each issue. New animals with different habitats meant new design challenges," explains Lafortune, adding, "There's a need to find new ways of seeing the animals each year."

Finding new images isn't the only challenge. As definitives, these will be among the most used stamps this year. "Similar to the design of a poster, everything on a stamp has to be easily identifiable at first sight," says Lafortune. "To achieve that visibility, we play with contrasts and colours to highlight the key element of each stamp."

Lafortune's favourite from the 2014 series is the puffin and its mother. She points to the contrast

between the almost monochromatic baby bird and the bright colour in the mother's beak.

About the animals

At birth, adorable baby beavers already have thick fur, sharp teeth and open eyes. They can see, hear, walk and even swim. After two years, kits leave the colony.

Mountain goat mothers bear their kids on the isolated ledges of the dangerous rocky terrain they call home. Just three days after birth, horns start to show and soon after, the kid is ready to explore and play with other youngsters.

Puffin males prepare burrows on ocean cliffs with grass, twig and feather linings. After 40 days, the 40-gram chick hatches and some five weeks later, takes its first flight at night.

Burrowing owl parents assure the comfort of their chicks by lining the burrow in feathers, dried plants and dry shredded cow manure. By August, the chicks begin living independently as they prepare for the annual migration to the south.

Wapiti – sometimes known as elk in North America – are born in May or early June after a gestation period of just over eight months. After birth, the cow hides her newborn until it can run if threatened.



Monarchs are a symbol of metamorphosis for their ability to transform from caterpillars to adult butterflies through chrysalis. In a similar way, this monarch 22-cent low-value definitive will transform your 63-cent stamp into the current domestic rate. The "make-up postage" stamp features Keith Martin's unique illustrative style found in the extensive series of low-value definitives issued over several years. Martin notes that "this issue let me take the 2009 two-cent stamp, which depicted the monarch caterpillar, literally to the next level."

A long distance traveller, the monarch butterfly leaves North America in late summer to migrate 4,000 kilometres over winter to the northwest of Mexico City. The return trip takes four generations.

Monarchs are found in most parts of central and eastern Canada and have been spotted as far north as James Bay. Sadly their numbers continue to decline each year due to habitat encroachment and the reduction of milkweed, their food of choice, from the use of herbicides. In fact, recent numbers reached a record low.

In addition to delighting collectors and serving as postage, the stamp will hopefully increase appreciation of the monarch, as it has done for the illustrator of the series. Keith Martin notes, "Helping Canada Post commemorate the complex life cycles of the monarch has renewed my interest in witnessing millions of these butterflies carpet a Mexican forest of oyamel fir trees – it's a personal bucket-list moment."

Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry, 100th Anniversary

Drawing on the rich visual heritage collected by the PPCLI Museum and Archives, this commemorative envelope celebrates the contributions and sacrifices made by members of the Regiment.

The large photograph recalls the Regiment's early days. In it, Princess Patricia of Connaught, for whom the new unit was named in 1914, presents a Wreath of Laurel for display on the Regimental Colours. Below, photographs document a century of service of the PPCLI, while on the reverse, a painting illustrates

the Regiment's sacrifices at the Battle of Frezenberg during the First World War.

The cancel features the letters and coronet from Princess Patricia's royal cypher. The letters "VP" – standing for the Princess's first names, Victoria Patricia – are also visible on the stamp above the now-disbanded regimental band.




