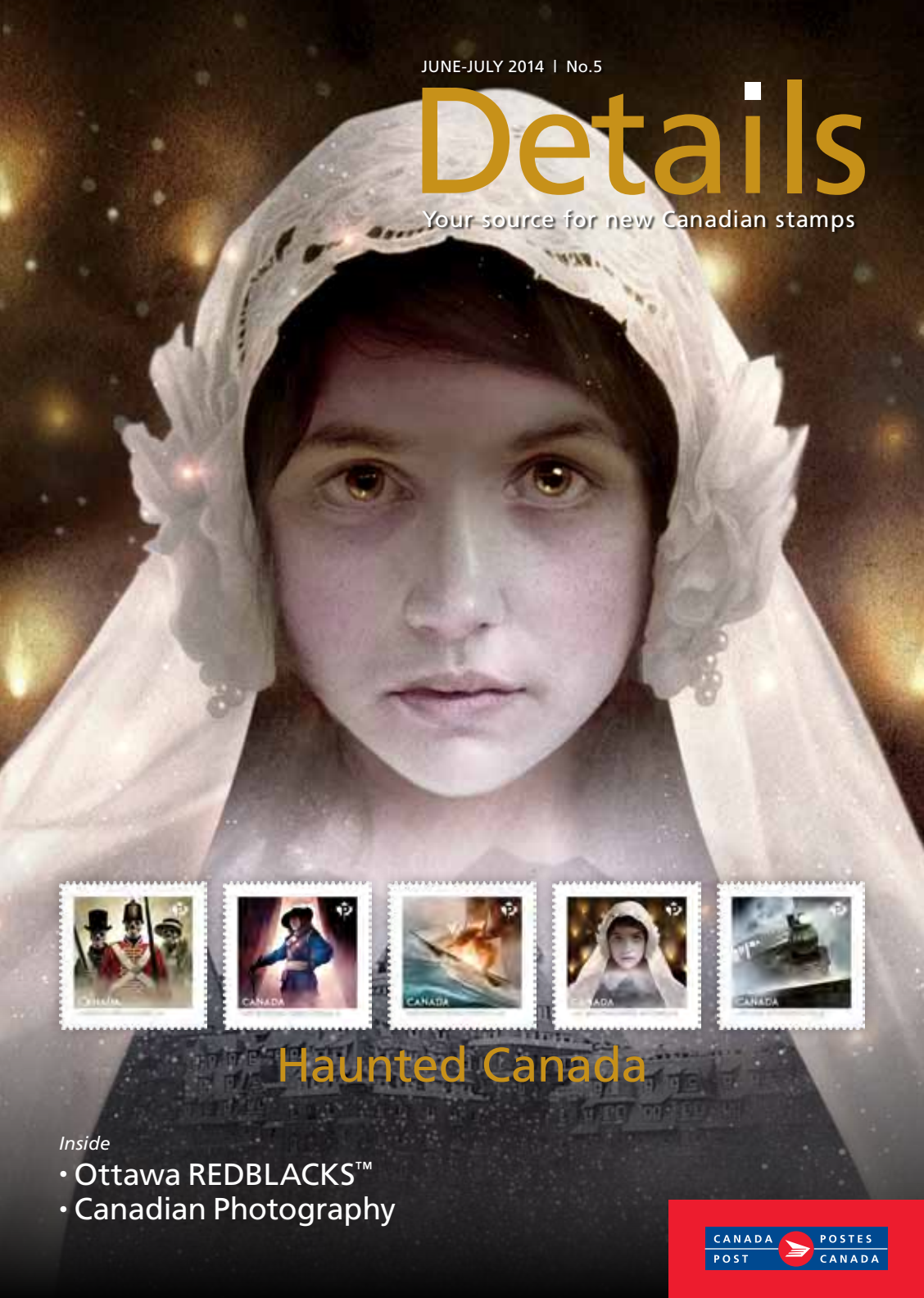

This commemorative envelope exhibits a few of the masterworks from the Art Gallery of Hamilton's permanent collection, which is recognized as one of the finest in Canada. Designed around eight well known works, this hand-held tour features *The Phantom Hunter* by William Blair Bruce. This eerie canvas – shown on the front of the envelope – was one of 29 paintings donated by the Bruce Family, a gift that resulted in the establishment of the institution in 1914. Another prized piece, *The Birch*

Grove, Autumn, by celebrated Canadian artist Tom Thomson, graces the Picture Postage™ stamp.

Over the past 100 years, the Art Gallery of Hamilton has acquired more than 10,000 works in its permanent collection, which is focused on 19th century European as well as historical and contemporary Canadian art. Today, the AGH has become a vital hub of creative development and artistic engagement, bringing art and people of all ages together.

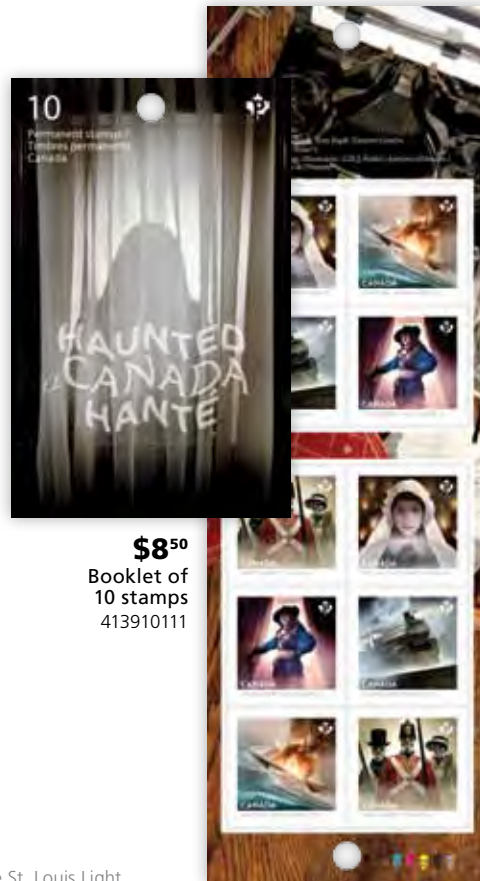

A fearsome fiction is one thing – but when the eerie story is based on accounts of real people who swear they've felt, heard or even seen a ghost – the supernatural is sensational! We're unleashing this spine-tingling series of five tales told across this land, with an Official First Day Cover cancelled in Gorrie, Ontario.

Haunts featured on the stamps

In the 1920s at the Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel, a young woman was descending the stairs on her wedding day when the heel of her shoe caught in her gown's train, and she tumbled down the steps to a

tragic end. Guests and hotel employees claim to have seen the lone bride dancing the wedding waltz by herself, then disappearing.

St. Louis, Saskatchewan, is home to the St. Louis Light, also known as the St. Louis Ghost Train. For over 80 years, on a stretch of abandoned rail north of town, some have witnessed a glowing light believed to be the spectre of a long dead Canadian National Railway (CNR) conductor who literally lost his head in the 1920s to a passing train.

Built between 1796 and 1799 and now a popular tourist site, Fort George at Niagara-on-the-Lake, Ontario, was key to British defenses and served as

British Army headquarters during the War of 1812. A young soldier is said to haunt the top floor of the barracks, and there are tales of a spirited little girl who was once bold enough to take the hand of a tour guide.

In the Fairmont Le Château Frontenac, the hotel's most famous otherworldly resident is French Governor Louis de Buade, Count of Frontenac. The Count fostered the growth of New France from 1672 to 1698, and his coat of arms marks the entrance to the Château, part of which lies on the site of his former home. Some have spotted him, dressed in 17th century garb, wandering the halls or floating through the ballroom.

The Northumberland Strait flows between Prince Edward Island to the north and New Brunswick and Nova Scotia to the south. A site of many shipwrecks, the strait is a watery grave for legions of seafarers. For at least the past 200 years, those nearby claimed to have seen a burning ship, and onlookers attempting a rescue have approached the vessel only to see it vanish in the mist.

OTTAWA REDBLACKS™

Issue date: June 19, 2014

As a newcomer to the Canadian Football League™, the REDBLACKS™ will take to the field this season to carve their own chapter in Ottawa's CFL® history. The team carries forward the legacy of the Ottawa Rough Riders and draws on the rich logging heritage of the region. This REDBLACKS issue celebrates the team in the same style as the stamps released for the 100th Grey Cup® Game in 2012, which featured a key player and a historic moment for each CFL team.

When designing the REDBLACKS stamp, Filip Mroz and David Rosenberg of Bensimon Byrne wanted to honour the team's heritage, while looking toward the future.

"This was a chance to bring the old and new together," explains Rosenberg. "We feature a renowned hero from the days of the Ottawa Rough Riders in dramatic stance on the left, while our moment is the new stadium – and the historic beginning it represents."

Filip Mroz adds his thoughts, "The attention to detail paid to the uniform along with the new REDBLACKS branding encompasses both new and old," he says. "The pairing shows that the future will be just as fabulous as the past has been."

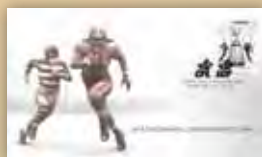

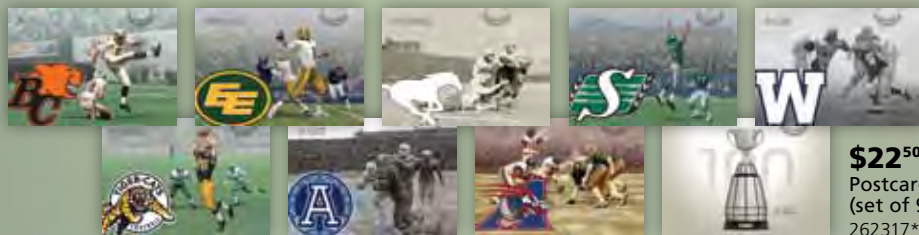

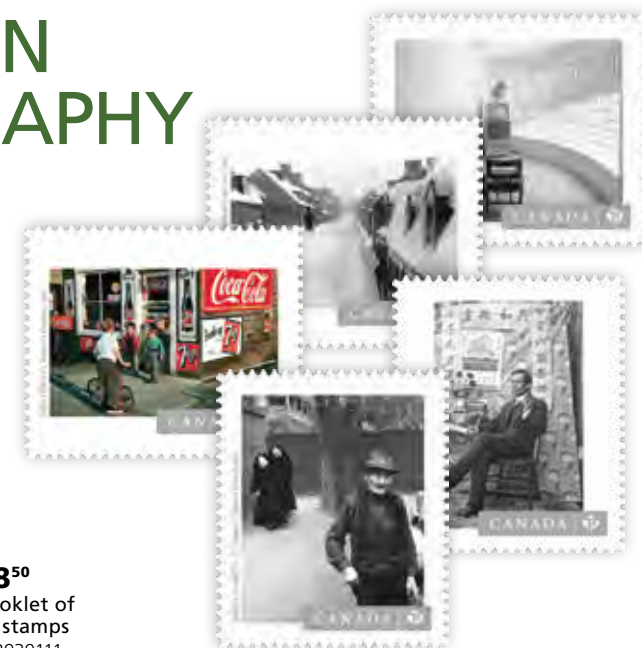

Imagine having to choose the best images to reflect Canadian photography from the past 150 years – and depict that talent in just seven stamps a year. That balancing act would demand expertise and judgment. In planning this multi-year series, Stamp Design Manager Alain Leduc approached a group of archivists and museum curators with historical and technical knowledge of photography in Canada.

They chose 35 photographers they deemed prominent in the history of Canadian photography. They were then asked to suggest one representative photograph from each artist. From this list, Leduc and his design team chose seven artists to be featured on

five domestic-rate stamps, one U.S. denomination and one international stamp for each year of the series. They also had to consider the period in which the photo was shot, the location, and its quality and integrity once reduced to stamp size.

The 2014 edition of the series includes domestic stamps featuring Fred Herzog's *Bogner's Grocery* (1960), Lynne Cohen's *Untitled* (1970), Michel Lambeth's *St. Joseph's Convent School* (1960), C.D. Hoy's *Unidentified Chinese man* (circa 1912) and Louis-Prudent Vallée's *Quebec City in Winter* (1894). William Notman's *Sitting Bull* and *Buffalo Bill* (1885) graces the U.S. denomination.

Edward Burtynsky's *Railcuts* #1, shot at Skihist Provincial Park in British Columbia in 1985, appears on the international stamp.

This series and the initial issue in 2013 were created by long-time stamp designer Stéphane Huot of Montréal. The two Official First Day Covers – one featuring horizontal shots and the other, vertical ones – were cancelled in Ottawa, Ontario.

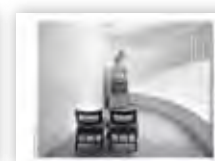

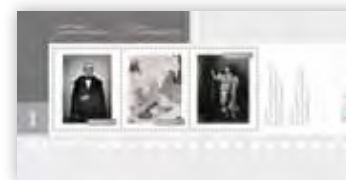

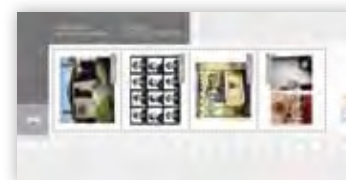
